The prayer in the petition under Section 438 Cr.PC is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.132 dated 27.09.2023 registered under Sections 326, 324, 341, 148, 149, 120-B, 201 IPC registered at P.S. Division No.2, District Pathankot.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 14.12.2023 **passed** by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State Counsel on instructions from submits that the petitioner has joined investigation in terms of orders dated 14.12.2023 and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In this view of the matter, interim order dated 14.12.2023 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
