KULDEEP TIWARI, J.(ORAL)

1. Through the instant petition, filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, a prayer is made for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus, directing the official respondents No.1 to 3, to ensure the protection of life and liberty of the petitioner, which is endangered at the hands of private respondents No.4 and 5.

2. In deference to the directions issued by this Court, by drawing an order dated 21.11.2024, status report dated 13.12.2024, by way of affidavit of Mr. Nirmal Singh, PPS, Assistant Commissioner of Police (Central), Commissionerate Jalandhar, on behalf of the respondents No.1 to 3, furnished by the learned State counsel today in the Court. The same is taken on the record. Copy thereof, supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner.

3. The study survey of the status report (supra), would reflect that the petitioner herself suffered a statement before the Enquiry Officer concerned, that she does not have any threat perception, as on date.



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4. In view of the above, no direction is required to be passed in the instant petition, and the same is hereby **closed**.
