two criminal miscellaneous petitions.

2. The instant petitions have been filed under Section 483 BNSS for grant of interim regular bail to the petitioner(s) for two weeks in case FIR No.4 dated 23.01.2024 under Sections 306 IPC (Section 304-B IPC added later on) registered at Police Station GRP, Faridkot, District Faridkot.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner(s) contends that the petitioner-Sandura Rani-aged about 70 years, mother of the co-accused namely Vijay Kumar and petitioner-Vinod Kumar Verma (brother of the co-accused) seek interim regular bail on the ground that co-accused-Vijay Kumar has died in jail on 11.11.2024. He further contends that both the petitioner(s) want to attend the Bhog ceremony of the deceased, which is scheduled for tomorrow i.e. 22.11.2024 from 01.00 pm to 02.00 pm at Maa Chintpurni Dharamshala, Near Geeta Bhawan, Moga.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner(s) submits that inadvertently Section 304-B IPC could not be added in the head note and prayer clause of the petition.

5. On oral request of learned counsel for the petitioner(s), Section 304-B IPC be read in the head note and prayer clause of the petition. Registry is directed to do the necessary corrections.

6. Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Karamjit Singh has verified about the said date and place of the Bhog ceremony.

7. Keeping in view the relationship of the petitioner(s) with the deceased, the present petitions are disposed of.

8. Both the petitioner(s) are ordered to be released on interim regular

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bail for a period of one week from the date of their release subject to their furnishing adequate bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the CJM, Faridkot/Duty Magistrate.

9. Both the petitioners shall surrender before the Jail authorities before 5.00 pm upon completion of one week.
10. Copy of this order be supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner(s) under the signatures of Bench Secretary.
11. All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, shall stand disposed of.
