GURVINDER SINGH GILL J, (ORAL)

1. Petitioners seek grant of interim bail for two weeks so as to make arrangements in connection with marriage of Sanjana, who is daughter of petitioner no.1 and grand daughter of petitioners no.2 and 3.
2. Notice of motion.
3. At this stage, Mr.Manish Sharma, DAG, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice.
4. A perusal of paragraph no.3 of the impugned order i.e the order passed by the learned Additional Sessions Judge (Fast Track Court), Panipat, shows that the assertion of the petitioners as regards solemnization of marriage of Sanjana, who is daughter of petitioner no.1 and grand daughter of petitioners no.2 and 3 on 27.11.2024 has been verified and found to be correct. The trial Court, however, declined the application while observing that the petitioners are involved in a serious offence of honour killing of their another daughter.
5. This Court having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case and while also bearing in mind, the nature of offence for which, the petitioners



have been booked in FIR No.347 dated 17.05.2023, under Sections 302, 201 and 120-B and 34 of IPC, registered at Police Station Chandni Bagh, Panipat, this Court, in any case, cannot overlook the fact that the presence of father of the girl to be married and also her grand parents will be required for performing the rites and ceremonies in connection with marriage of the girl i.e Sanjana, daughter of petitioner no.1 and grand daughter of petitioners no.2 and 3.

6. The petition, as such, is **accepted** to the limited extent by permitting the petitioners to attend the marriage of Sanjana, who is daughter of petitioner no.1 and grand daughter of petitioners no.2 and 3 on 27.11.2024 at Panipat.

7. The Superintendent Jail concerned shall make the requisite arrangements for taking the petitioners to the venue of marriage on 27.11.2024.

8. The petitioners shall, however, be allowed to remain at the venue of marriage only during the period from 11:00 am to 04:00 pm and shall be consigned back in jail thereafter. The petitioners would be required to deposit the expenses to be incurred for the conveyance and security.
