Learned counsel for respondent Nos. 1 & 2 refers to communication dated 13.12.2024, to contend that the name of petitioner has been recommended for the post of Lower Division Clerk to the Office of Dakshin Haryana Bijli Vitran Nigam, Hisar. The aforesaid communication dated 13.12.2024 produced by learned counsel for respondent Nos. 1 & 2, is taken on record.

[2] In turn, learned counsel for respondent Nos. 3 & 4 submits that the necessary provisional appointment shall be issued in favour of the petitioner upon his police verification / medical examination within a period of two weeks from today.

[3] In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the present petition any further.

[4] **Dismissed as not pressed.**

[5] However, in case the needful is not done within the afore-stated period, as per undertaking, the petitioner would be at liberty to seek revival of the present contempt petition and in that eventuality, the erring / concerned officer(s) would be liable to pay additional sum of Rs.50,000/- as costs from his/her own pocket in favour of the petitioner towards litigation expenses, immediately, i.e. on the first date of listing of revival application.

[5] Rule stands discharged.

[6] Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed off.
