1. Present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case bearing FIR No.128 dated 19.09.2021, registered for the offences punishable under Sections 22 and 29 of the NDPS Act, 1985 at Police Station Dhuri, District Sangrur.
2. As per the case of the prosecution, on 19.09.2021, the petitioner was apprehended by the police officials. From the personal search of the petitioner, 40 strips containing 400 intoxicant tablets make Tramwel and 300 loose intoxicant tablets were recovered.
3. Custody Certificate of the petitioner as well as status report by way of affidavit of Talwinder Singh Gill, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Dhuri, District Sangrur have been filed on behalf of the State today in Court, which are taken on record. As per the custody certificate, the petitioner has undergone

actual custody of 2 years, 3 months and 12 days. There is no other case against the petitioner.

4. State Counsel submits that there are 18 cited witnesses and only 02 have been examined as yet.

5. In view of above, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned. However, in addition to conditions that may be imposed by the Trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned, the petitioner shall remain bound by the following conditions :-

- (i) The petitioner shall not mis-use the liberty granted.
- (ii) The petitioner shall not tamper with any evidence oral or documentary during the trial.
- (iii) The petitioner shall not absent himself on any date before the trial.
- (iv) The petitioner shall not commit any offence while on bail.
- (v) The petitioner shall deposit his passport, if any with the trial Court.
- (vi) The petitioner shall give his cellphone number to the police authorities and shall not change his cell-phone number without permission of the trial Court.
- (vii) The petitioner shall not in any manner try to delay the trial.

6. In case of breach of any of the aforesaid conditions and those which may be imposed by the Trial Court, the prosecution shall be at liberty to move cancellation of bail of the petitioner.

7. Ordered accordingly.
