In criminal complaint bearing NACT No.10762 of 2017, titled as “***Juvalia Sales Pvt. Ltd. v. Minku Express Pvt. Ltd. and others***”, an application under Section 311 Cr.P.C. moved by the complainant of the case for additional evidence was allowed by learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Gurugram, vide impugned order dated 10.08.2023 (Annexure P-1).

2. Grievance of the petitioner-accused is that the documents allowed to be produced in the additional evidence, were already available with the complainant.

3. After hearing learned counsel and going through the impugned order, this Court finds no illegality in the impugned order, having regard to the wide scope of Section 311 Cr.P.C., as per which application can be moved at any stage. The Court has permitted the complainant to place on record the balance sheet pertaining to the year 2017-18, for the purpose of supporting the case of the complainant.

4. As such, finding no illegality in the impugned order, present petition is hereby dismissed.
