The petition has been filed, *inter alia*, seeking a writ of *mandamus* directing the respondents to grant all the benefits as per Clause 11 of the Teacher Transfer Policy, 2016 (amended from time to time) and letter dated 10.05.2018 along with interest of eighteen per cent per annum.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that grievance raised herein is pending for appropriate decision before the respondents. At this stage, the petitioner will be satisfied in case respondent No. 2 is directed to decide his pending legal notice, dated 19.08.2024, Annexure P-5, in a specified period.

5. In view of the statement made, learned counsel for the petitioner has no objection to the petition being disposed of in terms thereof.
6. Ordered accordingly.
7. In case the order is not passed within the stipulated period, the officer concerned shall pay costs of ₹50,000 to the petitioner.
