ANIL KSHETARPAL, J. (Oral)

1. The petitioner (minor) has filed this petition through his father Kamaljeet Singh. He prays for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to renew his passport/issue a fresh passport as he intends to go abroad for his treatment.
2. It has been disclosed that the petitioner's father was previously married to Smt. Jaskiran Kaur. However, after decree of divorce by mutual consent passed on 08.03.2017, he has remarried to Sandeep Kaur.
3. Mr. Ashutosh Dhankar, Advocate, has entered appearance on behalf of respondent No.1 and submits that the petitioner is required to produce the decree of divorce and the statement given by Smt. Jaskiran Kaur in the second motion during proceedings under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955.
4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the aforesaid documents shall be supplied within a period of one week.
5. Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, the present petition is disposed of with direction to the Regional Passport Office, Chandigarh, to process petitioner's application for issuance of passport within 15 days from the date of receipt of certified copies of both the documents.
