HARKESH MANUJA J. (Oral)

1. Learned counsel for the respondents, on instructions from Mr. Ved Parkash Dhull, Under Secretary to Govt. of Haryana, Development & Panchayat Department, submits that the charge sheet against the petitioner stands dropped, however, his promotion case shall be considered and if found favourable, the consequential benefits shall be awarded to him within a period of 04 weeks from today.

2. In view thereof, no cause survives in the present petition, as such, the same is disposed of. Rule stands discharged.

However, in case the needful is not done within the afore-stated period, as per undertaking, the petitioner would be at liberty to seek revival of the present contempt petition and in that eventuality, the dealing official

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as well as the officer concerned would be liable to pay a sum of Rs.50,000/- each (total 01 lakh) as costs from their own pockets in favour of the petitioner towards litigation expenses, immediately, i.e. on the first date of listing of revival application.
