The petitioner is seeking extension of parole for a period of four weeks.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner had been granted parole for a period of four weeks as his mother is unwell. She further submits that the mother of the petitioner has to undergo surgery on 23.11.2024. The report of the hospital is at Annexure P-3.

3. Issue notice to the respondents.

4. Mr. Rajiv Vij, Addl. P.P., U.T., Chandigarh accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and submits that the mother of the petitioner is suffering from gallbladder ailment and the petitioner has been granted adequate time to spend with his mother, therefore, there is no cause to extend the parole.

5. Heard.

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6. The petitioner has been convicted in FIR No.25 dated 31.01.2018 and sentenced to undergo RI for 15 years along with fine of Rs.1,55,000/- under Section 6 of the POCSO Act and RI for one year along with fine of Rs.2000/- under Section 506 IPC. The petitioner has been granted parole for a period of four weeks to look after his mother. His mother is stated to be unwell and has to be operated upon on 23.11.2024. It would be in the interest of justice, if the period of parole is extended by 15 days.

7. Consequently, the petition is allowed and the period of parole of the petitioner is extended by 15 days and on expiry of period of 15 days, he shall surrender to the concerned jail.
