In the present petition, the grievance being raised by the petitioners in the present petition is that the petitioners are entitled for the grant of increment keeping in view the judgment of the Hon'ble Surpeme Court of India in Civil Appeal No.2471 of 2023 titled “ *Director (Admn. and HR) KPTCL and Others Vs. C.P. Mundinamani and Others*”, decided on 11.04.2023.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have already raised the said grievance in the legal notice dated 09.06.2024(Annexure P-5) but the same is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioners will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a

direction is issued to the respondents to decide the same by passing an appropriate speaking order in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr.Ashish Yadav, Addl. A.G., Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and submits that in case, the legal notice dated 09.06.2024(Annexure P-5) has been received in the office of the concerned authorities and the same is still pending consideration with the authorities concerned, the same will be decided by the competent authority within a period of eight weeks from the date of the receipt of certified copy of this order by passing an appropriate speaking order. Learned counsel further submits that in case, it is found feasible to accept the claim of the petitioners, the same will be accepted, otherwise due reasons will be mentioned for not accepting the claim of the petitioners in the speaking order to be passed and the said order will be duly conveyed to the petitioners.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that keeping in view the statement of learned counsel for the respondents, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
