NAMIT KUMAR, J. (ORAL)

1. The petitioners have filed in the instant writ petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking a writ of mandamus directing the respondents to regularize the services of the petitioners in view of Punjab Government Policy dated 04.03.1999 (Annexure P-1) and to give all the consequential benefits arising therefrom.

2. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that the services of petitioner No.1 have already been regularized on 15.03.2024 and the claim of petitioners No.2 and 3 with regard to regularization of their services has been rejected vide orders dated 18.03.2024 and 14.05.2024, respectively. Copies of orders dated 18.03.2024 and 14.05.2024 have been produced in the Court which are taken on record. Copies thereof have been supplied to learned counsel for the petitioners.

3. Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the



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petitioners wishes to withdraw the instant petition with liberty to file a fresh one impugning the orders dated 18.03.2024 and 14.05.2024.

4. Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as aforesaid.
