NAMIT KUMAR, J.

1. Instant Writ Petition has been filed by the petitioner impugning the action of the respondents in issuing fresh appointment order at the time of his absorption as Senior Assistant and not relating back the same from the date of his initial appointment as Assistant Treasurer on account of his retrenchment.

2. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that let this petition be disposed of only with a direction to respondent No.2 – Director, Department of Employment Generation, Skill Development and Training, Punjab, to consider and decide the notice of demand dated 08.05.2023 (Annexure P-9) submitted by the petitioner.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Arun Gupta, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents.

5. Accordingly, and without commenting upon the merits of the claim of the petitioner and even the assertions set out in the petition,

the same is disposed of only with a direction to respondent No.2 that if any such notice, as indicated above, is indeed pending consideration, that shall be dealt with expeditiously in accordance with law by passing a speaking order preferably within three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order and convey the same to the petitioner.

6. The present petition stands disposed of accordingly.
