1. The petitioners are aggrieved by the fact that free, fair and impartial investigation is not being conducted in FIR No. 73 dated 06.05.2024 under Section 21 of the NDPS Act, 1985, registered against them at Police Station Special Task Force, District STF Wing.
2. The petitioners – accused have an alternative remedy under Section 156 (3) of the Code of Criminal Procedure (Section 175 of BNSS) and Section 200 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (Section 223 of BNSS) before the Magistrate of the area concerned which can very well be invoked by them.
3. With the aforesaid liberty, the petition stands disposed of.
