On 15.12.2023, the following order was passed by this
Court:-

“By way of present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., petitioner has prayed for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.250 dated 17.11.2023 registered under Sections 419, 420, 465, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC at Police Station Bhikhi, District Mansa.

It is contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the impugned sale deed was executed wayback on 05.06.1995, whereby petitioner had purchased 6 kanal 10 marlas of land. It is in 2017 when the complaint was made by alleging that some fake lady was produced so as to sell the land in favour of the petitioner.

Learned counsel then pointed out that FIR has been lodged in November, 2023, i.e. after another six years from the date of making the complaint. Learned counsel also pointed out that even the civil suit was filed by mother of the complainant, i.e. vendor of the petitioner but that civil suit was dismissed on 23.04.2018.

Notice of motion.

Mr. M.S. Nagra, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent- State. Copy of the petition be supplied to him during course of the day.

Adjourned to 05.03.2024.

In the meantime, in case of his arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer/ Investigating Officer. However, it is further directed that the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when so required by the Investigating Officer. He shall not contact any person associated with the case to dissuade him from the investigation in any manner whatsoever and nor shall leave the country without prior permission of the Court. He shall further comply with the conditions stipulated in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

2. Today, on instructions from H.C. Gurpreet Singh, learned State counsel has informed this Court that the petitioner has joined the investigation, in compliance of the order dated 15.12.2023 and is no longer required for further investigation.

3. In view of the aforesaid, the order dated 15.12.2023, whereby the petitioner was granted interim anticipatory bail, is hereby made absolute. However, he shall continue to join investigation, if and so required by the Investigating Officer.
