1. The present petition has been filed by the petitioner seeking direction to respondents No.1 to 3 to take appropriate legal action on the representation dated 12.09.2023 and 14.10.2023 (Annexure P-6 and P-7) against respondent No.4.
2. The State counsel filed compliance report by way of affidavit of Jatin Bansal, Assistant Commissioner of Police, Civil Lines, Ludhiana on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3.
3. The State counsel while referring to aforesaid compliance report, submits that as per the record maintained in office of Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana., no such representations given by the petitioner are available.
4. Faced with this situation, the counsel for the petitioner submits that he is having copies of the said representations with him and further

made prayer that the petitioner be given liberty to give fresh representation with direction to respondent No.2 to decide the same, in accordance with law in a time bound manner.

5. The prayer is not opposed by the State counsel.
6. In light of the above discussion, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the present petition is hereby disposed of with direction to the petitioner to file representation spelling out his grievances within next 10 days and on his doing so, any such representation submitted by the petitioner is to be considered and decided by respondent No.2 within a period of three weeks thereof, in accordance with law.
