The present writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus for directing official respondents No.1 to 5 for taking appropriate legal action for releasing the allowances/emoluments to the petitioner/Chairman Zila Parishad Moga from month 1/2022 to till date as per entitlement and applicable in accordance with rules and regulations issued vide notifications dated 10.09.1996 (Annexure P-9) and 20.11.2014 (Annexure P-10) of Government of Punjab, Department of Rural Development and Panchayat.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that for redressal of grievance of the petitioner, he has submitted an application dated 30.08.2024 (Annexure P-6), but the same has not been adverted to by the concerned authorities, till date.

3. On advance copy of petition having been served upon the State,

Mr. Navneet Singh, Sr. DAG, Punjab, appears on behalf of respondents-

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State.

4. Learned State counsel submits that respondent No.2 (Director, Department of Rural Development and Panchayats, S.A.S. Nagar)/competent authority shall take decision either way, on the pending application dated 30.08.2024 (Annexure P-6) of the petitioner within a period of two months from today.

5. Keeping in view the aforesaid submissions made by learned State counsel, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he does not intend to press the instant writ petition any further, at this stage.

6. Keeping in view the submissions made by learned counsel for the parties and without commenting on the merits of the case, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 (Director, Department of Rural Development and Panchayats, S.A.S. Nagar)/competent authority to consider and decide application dated 30.08.2024 (Annexure P-6) of the petitioner by way of passing a speaking order, after affording due opportunity of hearing to all the concerned parties, within a period of two months from today.

7. All the pending application(s), if any, shall also stand closed.
