The prayer in the petition under Section 438 Cr.PC is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.109 dated 19.08.2023 registered under Sections 324, 323, 341, 506, 427, 148, 149, 326 IPC (Section 326 IPC added later) registered at P.S. Mamdot, District Ferozepur.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 18.12.2023 passed by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State Counsel on instructions submits that the petitioner has joined investigation in terms of orders dated 18.12.2023 and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In this view of the matter, interim order dated 18.12.2023 is

made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
