1. The petitioner has filed the present petition with a prayer to issue writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus for release of the alleged detainee, namely, Nirjala, daughter of the petitioner.
2. In compliance of the order dated 25.11.2024 passed by this Court, the alleged detainee, namely, Nirjala, has been produced before the Court. She submits that the present petitioner is the sister of her mother. Her mother has already expired. Her father is a drunkard and used to beat her up. Consequently, she left her home voluntarily with Rohit respondent No. 4 and has performed marriage with him. At present, she is staying with respondent No. 4 happily in the matrimonial home and does not want to take action against him. She further submits that she is not illegally confined by any person and wishes to stay with respondent No. 4 only.
3. In view of the statement made by the alleged detainee, namely, Nirjala, no further orders are required to be passed by this Court.
4. Since, the alleged detainee, namely, Nirjala, is major, she is permitted to go to a place of her choice.
