1. The petitioners are seeking the concession of anticipatory bail under Section 438 of the Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.227 dated 22.08.2022 under Sections 324, 506, 34 of the IPC (Section 326 of the IPC added lateron), registered at Police Station Jandiala, District Amritsar Rural.

2. On 16.12.2023, while noticing the following submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioners, this Court had granted the concession of interim bail to the petitioner and asked them to join investigation:-

“Learned counsel inter alia contends that the petitioners, who are husband and wife, have been attributed only kick and fist blows on the person of the injured.”

3. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in compliance of order dated 16.12.2023, the petitioners have joined investigation and cooperated with the investigating agency.

4. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Nishan Singh, does not dispute the factum of the petitioners having joined investigation and cooperated with the investigating agency. He, on further instructions, submits that the petitioners are not required for further investigation much less for their custodial interrogation.

5. In view of the above, the petition is allowed and interim order dated 16.12.2023, is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
