As per office report, notice to respondents No.6 and 13 could not be issued for want of process fee.

Learned counsel appearing for respondents No.3 to 5 submits that the present writ petition has seemingly been rendered infructuous since the petitioner wanted to participate in the School National Taekwondo Competition which was scheduled to be held in Betul, Madhya Pradesh, from 31.12.2023 to 05.01.2024. She contends that since the tournament has already concluded, the petitioner has no further grievance which subsists for adjudication in the present case.

There is no rebuttal to the aforesaid contention.

Therefore, while keeping the question of law raised in the present writ petition open, the same is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.

Liberty, however, is granted to the petitioner to seek revival of the present writ petition in case he feels that there is still a subsisting grievance.
