Prayer in the present petition is for issuance of official respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner from private respondents No.4 to 6 as they are extending threats and respondent No.4 is openly stating that he will kill the petitioner and her family and further threatened her that her marriage will be spoiled which is scheduled for 30.11.2024.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is a young girl whose marriage is fixed for 30.11.2024. He has submitted that respondent No.4 is her brother-in-law, who is married to her sister. He submits that both her sister and brother-in-law are living in Australia and divorce proceedings are going on between them in Australia. He submits that now respondent No.4 has come to India and he is threatening to spoil the marriage of the petitioner, which is fixed for 30.11.2024. He further submits that the petitioner has already filed a representation dated 24.10.2024 (Annexure P-2) to respondent No.2, however, no action has been taken on the same till date.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 i.e. Senior Superintendent of Police, Faridkot to decide the representation dated 24.10.2024 (Annexure P-2) filed by the petitioner in accordance with law and grant immediate protection, if any threat to the life and liberty of the petitioner and her family, is perceived.
