1. Instant writ petition has been filed for directing the respondents to pay arrears of pension on revision of pension on higher wages as per the madate issued by the Hon'ble Apex Court and notification No.Pension-I/12/33/EPS Amendment/96/Vol.II dated 23.03.2017 (Annexure P-2).

2. In para 19 of the writ petition, following averments have been made: -

“19. That the Central Provident Fund Organisation issued instructions to all Addl. CPFCs, Zonal Officers/All/OICs Regional No.Pension/2022/55893/15785 dated 25.01.2023 to re-examine the cases on higher wages, of employees who had retired upto 1st September, 2014 without exercising any option under Para 11(3) of the pre amended EPS'95. The respondents no.2&3 reverted the pension of the pensioners including the petitioners to the old pension. The above action of the



respondents no.2 and 3 was challenged by the pensioners including the petitioners before the high courts throughout the country and the Hon’ble high courts in an interim order restored the pension on higher wages.”

- 3. Although the writ petitions have been filed by the petitioners, however, the details have not been given in this petition.
- 4. Faced with this situation learned counsel for the petitioners wishes to withdraw the present petition with liberty to file fresh one on the same cause of action with better particulars by providing the numbers of the cases which have been filed by the petitioners.
- 5. Dismissed as withdrawn with aforesaid liberty.
