1. The instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, *inter alia*, seeking a writ in the nature of Mandamus for directing the respondents to conduct demarcation of land belonging to the petitioners.
2. After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioners prays for withdrawal of the instant writ petition with liberty to petitioners to pursue their remedies before the Civil Court, where, as per his own statement, the proceedings are pending.
3. Keeping in view the aforesaid submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioners, the present writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty aforesaid.
