1. The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. with a prayer to grant anticipatory bail to him in case FIR No.0178 dated 24.08.2022, registered under Section 22 of NDPS Act (Section 29 of NDPS Act added subsequently), at Police Station City South Moga, District Moga.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 16.12.2023 passed by a Co-ordinate Bench of this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.
3. Learned counsel for the State has submitted that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for further investigation.
4. In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the parties, the present petition is allowed and the interim order dated 16.12.2023, passed by a Co-ordinate Bench of this Court is made absolute. The petitioner shall continue to join investigation, as and when called by the Investigating Officer and shall also abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
