AMARJOT BHATTI, J.

1. Petitioner Kala Singh filed petition under Section 528 of BNSS, 2023 for setting aside impugned order dated 31.10.2023 (Annexure P-12) and order dated 13.11.2024 (Annexure P-16) passed by learned Judge, Special Court, Kapurthala in FIR No.164, dated 04.12.2020 under Sections 15 of the NDPS Act registered at Police Station Talwandi Chaudrian, District Kapurthala (P-1) whereby bail bonds and surety bonds of petitioner have been cancelled and forfeited to the State and next date fixed in this case is 18.01.2025 according to which proclamation proceedings have been initiated against petitioner.

2. Learned counsel for petitioner, at this stage, argued that he restricts his prayer to the extent that petitioner is ready to surrender before the trial Court and his regular bail application may be decided within one week.

3. Notice of motion.
4. On asking of this Court, Mr. Neeraj Madaan, Sr. DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of State.
5. Considering the aforesaid factual position, petition filed by petitioner is allowed only to the extent that he will surrender before the trial Court within a period of 10 days and thereafter his regular bail application may be decided within a span of 7 days preferably on merits.
6. With this direction, petition is, accordingly, disposed of.
