Petitioner has filed the present writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a writ in the nature of Mandamus for directing respondent No.1 to take appropriate final decision on the notification dated 13.12.2021 (Annexure P-1), whereby it was proposed to fix the boundaries to Municipal Corporation, S.A.S. Nagar as shown in the Schedule of Boundary (attached with the said notification).

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that vide aforesaid notification dated 13.12.2021 (Annexure P-1), objections/suggestions were called from the general public; however the proposal has not been finalized till date. Accordingly, he prays that time bound directions be issued to respondent No.1 to take final decision in the matter.

3. At this stage, Mr. Navneet Singh, Sr. DAG, Punjab appears on behalf of the respondents/State, in pursuance of the advance copy of paper book having already been served upon the State and does not dispute the fact



13.12.2021(Annexure P-1) is pending consideration with the authorities. However, he submits that the competent authority shall take decision either way, on the notification dated 13.12.2021 (Annexure P-1), within a period of six months from today.

4. Keeping in view the aforesaid submissions made by learned State counsel, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he does not intend to press the instant writ petition any further, at this stage.

5. Ordered accordingly.

6. All pending application(s), if any, shall also stand closed.
