1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to respondents to count his service rendered during Second National Emergency for the grant of pensionary benefits.

Mr. Aman Dhir, DAG, Punjab, who on advance notice is present in Court, submits that vide order dated 06.11.2024, Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar has held that service of petitioner rendered in Indian Army during Second National Emergency would be counted towards civil pension.
