RAJBIR SEHRAWAT, J. (Oral)

1. This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 10/12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, for punishing the respondents for disobeying the order dated 09.02.2023 passed in CWP-23807-2018.
2. Compliance report by way of affidavit of Ghanshyam Thori, Deputy Commissioner, Amritsar, filed in the Registry, is taken on record.
3. Counsel for the respondents submits that the order dated 09.02.2023 passed in CWP-23807-2018 has since been complied with and necessary payments alongwith interest @ 6% per annum or 9% per annum wherever applicable, have been made to the petitioner through RTGS.
4. Counsel for the petitioner has not even disputed the aforesaid fact.
5. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.
6. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left unredressed, she would be at liberty to raise the same in any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
