1. Petitioner Devdutt has filed petition under Section 483 read with Section 528 of BNSS, 2023 for grant of *interim* bail in FIR No. 312 dated 26.09.2024, under Section 22(B) of NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Kasola, Haryana, for a period of 20 days w.e.f. 25.11.2024 to 15.12.2024 to make arrangements for marriage of his daughter fixed for 11.12.2024.

2. As per the facts of case, present petitioner was apprehended by police with recovery of 96 capsules of Dicyclonine Tramadol Hcl Acetaminophen, total weight 56.04 grams and on the basis of this recovery, present FIR has been registered.

3. Report has been received from respondent-State of Haryana, confirming the factum of marriage of daughter of petitioner, fixed for 11.12.2024. Statement of wife of petitioner is recorded, which is Annexure

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R-1. Statement of Municipal Counsellor is Annexure R-2 and joint statement of respectables is Annexure R-3. However, interim bail of petitioner is opposed.

4. I have considered the aforesaid factual position. Petitioner is involved in another FIR and in CRM-M-59322-2024 vide order dated 02.12.2024, petitioner has been granted *interim* bail forthwith upto 14.12.2024, subject to his furnishing bail bonds and two heavy surety bonds to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned, for the purpose of marriage of his daughter. Present case relates to recovery of contraband falling in non-commercial quantity. It is confirmed that petitioner is to perform marriage of his daughter. Considering the aforesaid factual position, petitioner is granted *interim* bail as per terms and conditions mentioned in order dated 02.12.2024 passed in CRM-M-59322-2024, upto 14.12.2024.

5. Petition is, accordingly, disposed of.

6. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, stand disposed of accordingly as well.
