This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 11 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, for initiating contempt proceedings against the respondents for disobedience of the order dated 25.08.2023 passed in CWP-15493-2022.

Short reply by way of affidavit of respondent No.1 and short reply by way of affidavit of respondent No.2 have been filed by learned counsel for the respondents today in the Court. The same are taken on record. Registry is directed to scan the same and place it at appropriate place.

Learned counsel for the respondents has submitted that the order dated 25.08.2023 passed in CWP-15493-2022 has been complied with. The committee as mentioned in the order dated 25.08.2023 has submitted its enquiry report. Not only that, learned counsel for the respondents has submitted that necessary action thereon has also been taken.

In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.

However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left un-addressed, he would be at liberty to raise the same in any alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
