On 19.12.2023, the following order was passed in this case:-

“The prayer in the present petition under Section 482 Cr.PC is for quashing of the order dated 09.10.2023 passed by the Additional Sessions Judge, Jalandhar vide which non bailable warrants of arrest of the petitioner have been issued in FIR No.140 dated 31.10.2020 under Sections 392, 379-B, 379, 380, 454 and 457 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959 registered at Police Station Division No.2, District Jalandhar.

The learned counsel for the petitioner contends that on 09.10.2023, the petitioner was unable to attend the Court proceedings and was suffering from various ailments as was evidenced from Annexure P-3. He states that the petitioner is ready and willing to join the proceedings once again.

In the meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to surrender before the Trial Court within a period of one week from today



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and subject to a deposit of Rs.25,000/- as costs with the Punjab and Haryana High Court Bar Association, Chandigarh Lawyers Family Welfare Fund, Account No.41564846387, SBI High Court Branch, IFSC:-SBIN0050306, he shall be admitted to interim bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

The learned counsel for the petitioner shall produce the receipt regarding deposit of Rs.25,000/- with the aforesaid Association as well as a copy of the order granting interim bail to the petitioner on the next date of hearing”.

On February 14, 2024, the following order was passed:-

“The prayer in the application under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for extension of time for complying with the order dated 19.12.2023 passed by this Court.

The status report by way of affidavit dated 14.02.2024 of the Assistant Commissioner of Police, Central Jalandhar filed today in the Court is taken on record.

Having heard the learned counsel for the parties and in view the reasons enumerated in the application, the same is allowed and one week time is granted to the petitioner to comply with the order dated 19.12.2023.

Adjourned to 21.02.2024.

Interim order to continue.”

The learned counsel for the petitioner contends that in deference to the aforementioned orders, the petitioner has surrendered before the Court of Additional Sessions Judge, Jalandhar and has since been released on bail vide order dated 16.02.2024. A copy thereof is taken on record as Mark ‘A’. A receipt showing the deposit of Rs.25,000/- with the



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19.12.2023 has also been produced in the Court. The same is taken on record as Mark ‘B’.

In view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed by this Court. Disposed of.

It is expected that the petitioner shall henceforth not absent himself from the Trial but for a sufficient cause.
