- Both the petitions are being decided by the common order as the identical dispute is between the same parties. However, the facts are being taken from CRM-M-7298-2024.
- Learned counsel for the petitioner *inter alia* contends that the complaint was filed on 27.04.2021 and the respondent was summoned on 08.07.2021. Thereafter, the trial of the case has not made much progress as the respondent is delaying the trial on one pretext or the other. As per the

mandate of Section 143(3) Cr.P.C. the trial is required to be concluded within a period of six months. Learned counsel for the petitioner prays for issuance of direction to the learned trial Court to conclude the trial in a time bound manner.

3. Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner and after perusing the record of the case, it transpires that the respondent has put in appearance and notice of accusation was served upon him on 16.01.2024.

4. In view of the facts and circumstances of the case, this Court finds no ground to issue any such direction.

5. Both the petitions are dismissed.
