The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. with a prayer to grant anticipatory bail to him in case FIR No.68 dated 14.06.2023, registered under Sections 379, 341, 506, 148, 149 of IPC and Section 21 of Mining and Minerals Act, 1957, at Police Station Koomkalan, Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 18.12.2023, passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned counsel for the State has submitted that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for further investigation.
