1. Present revision petition has been filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India for directing the trial Court to decide the petition bearing HMA No.65 of 2023 titled as 'Vijay Kumar Vs. Saroj Kumari and others', pending in the Court of Principal Judge, Family Court, Nangal, within a time frame.

2. A perusal of the paper-book would show that the petitioner had filed a petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, in which notice of motion was issued on 06.12.2023 and on 28.08.2024, the written statement was filed by respondent No.1, whereas, respondents No.3 and 4 filed application for dismissal of the petition and the case was adjourned to 11.12.2024. It is apparent that the present case is of the year 2023 and is at the initial stage. Thus, no ground is made out for taking the present case out of turn and the present revision petition, being meritless, deserves to be dismissed and is accordingly dismissed.
