RAJBIR SEHRAWAT, J. (Oral)

1. This is a contempt petition filed under Section 10 read with Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, for punishing the respondent for disobeying the order dated 21.12.2022 passed in CWP-2911-2022.
2. Counsel for the respondent submits that the order dated 21.12.2022 passed in CWP-2911-2022 has been complied with and necessary amounts, including the costs imposed by this Court, vide order dated 21.12.2022, have already been paid to the petitioner. Copy of communication dated 22.07.2024 to that effect, has been produced by the counsel for the respondent in the Court today. The same is taken on record. Registry is directed to scan and tag it at an appropriate place.
3. Counsel for the petitioner has not even disputed the aforesaid fact.
4. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.
5. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left unredressed, she would be at liberty to raise the same in any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
