VIKAS BAHL, J.(ORAL)

1. The present Civil Revision Petition has been filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India for setting aside the impugned order dated 23.11.2023 (Annexure P-6) passed by the trial Court whereby the application filed by the petitioner under order 26 Rule 9 CPC for appointing the Local Commissioner has been dismissed.
2. It has been brought to the notice of this Court that vide order dated 10.10.2024, the main suit as well as the counter claim have been dismissed in default under Order 9 Rule 3 CPC and thus, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.
3. In view of the above, present Civil Revision Petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
4. Liberty is granted to the petitioner to revive the petition, in case, the suit is restored or any other cause of action survives.
