AMARJOT BHATTI, J.

1. After arguing for some time, learned counsel for petitioner states that he intends to withdraw present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. read with Section 210 Cr.P.C. for clubbing of FIR No. 199 dated 20.07.2023 (Annexure P-3), under Section 323, 325, 307 of IPC, 1860 and Section 27 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station Nangal Chaudhri and FIR No.201 dated 21.07.2023 (Annexure P-4), under Sections 148, 149, 323, 379, 201, 506 of IPC, registered at Police Station Nangal Chaudhri, District Mahendergarh in one court with liberty to seek appropriate remedy by filing application before learned Sessions Judge, Narnaul as per law.
2. In view of the statement, present petition stands dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for.
3. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, stand disposed of accordingly.
