1. This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India, for punishing the respondents for disobeying the order dated 17.10.2023 passed in CWP-23533-2023.
2. Compliance report by way of affidavit of Dr. Mukta Kumar, Civil Surgeon, Panchkula, filed in the Court today, is taken on record. Registry is directed to scan and tag it at an appropriate place.
3. Counsel for the respondents submits that the order dated 17.10.2023 passed in CWP-23533-2023 has since been complied with; speaking order dated 08.02.2024 (Annexure R-1) has been passed and the necessary payments have been made to the petitioner, as is evident from the document (Annexure R-2).
4. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.
5. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left unredressed, he would be at liberty to raise the same in any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
