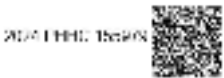

Instant petition under Section 528 of BNSS has been preferred seeking directions to respondents No.1 to 3 to take appropriate legal action against respondent No.4.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner, inter alia, contends that the petitioner being the owner of the car bearing registration No.HR-94A-9711, which was got financed from respondent No.4 and the respondent No.4 is continuously threatening the petitioners to take forcible possession thereof without following the due process and aggrieved by the same, the petitioners had moved the representation vide postal receipt dated 11.11.2024 (Annexure P-2) to respondent No.2 – Superintendent of Police, Mandi Dabwali, District Sirsa but till date no action thereon has been taken. He further submits that for the purpose of the petition, the petitioner will be satisfied if appropriate directions are given to respondent No. 2 to



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consider and dispose of the representation dated 11.11.2024 (Annexure P-2), in accordance with law in an expeditious manner.

- 3. Notice of motion to official respondents.
- 4. On the asking of the Court, Ms. Gaganpreet Kaur, DAG, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the State-respondents No. 1 to 3 and submits that the aforesaid representation will be disposed of in an expeditious manner in accordance with law.
- 5. After considering the rival contentions and considering the limited request made by learned counsel for the petitioner and without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.2 – Superintendent of Police, Mandi Dabwali, District Sirsa to consider and dispose of the representation dated 11.11.2024 (Annexure P-2), in accordance with law in an expeditious manner.
- 6. The decision so taken be intimated to the petitioner.
- 7. Disposed of.
