1 Present petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for protection of life and liberty of the petitioner and his family members.

2 Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Baljinder Singh submits that the inquiry is being conducted on the complaint made by the petitioner. However as per the statement of the petitioner recorded by the police authorities the petitioner has compromised the matter with Munish and Diskha i.e. respondents No.4 & 5 but wants to pursue his complaint against Rahul and Seema i.e. respondents No.6 & 7 but the address given by the petitioner of the aforesaid two accused is not correct one.
