1. By way of present petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India read with Section 482 Cr.P.C., prayer has been made for issuance of direction to the respondents to release the petitioner from jail on completion of his sentence in terms of instructions/notification dated 13.08.2008 (Annexure P-1).
2. Upon advance notice, Mr. Chetan Sharma, DAG, Haryana appears on behalf of the respondents-State and submits that the petitioner has never approached the State authorities in order to seek his grievance. Learned State counsel further submits that he has not received the copy of the paper book.
