Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner under Section 482 of BNSS, 2023 in criminal case having FIR No.184 dated 02.08.2019 registered under Sections 411, 201, 379-B of IPC at Police Station City Phagwara, District Kapurthala.

2. Counsel for the petitioner *inter alia* submits that earlier the petitioner was granted regular bail and thereafter he was appearing before the trial Court on each and every date of hearing. However, the petitioner got absented on 06.11.2024 and resultantly his bail/surety bonds were cancelled and the learned trial Court issued non-bailable warrants of arrest against the petitioner for 27.11.2024, in a hasty manner. It is further submitted that the absence of the petitioner before the trial Court on 06.11.2024 was not intentional and rather his absence on that date before the trial Court was on account of the fact that he mistook the date of



hearing. It is further submitted that the petitioner is ready to join proceedings before the trial Court at the earliest.

3. Notice of motion.
4. Mr. Jasjeet Singh Dhaliwal, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the State and on instructions from ASI Jatinder Pal Singh submits that no doubt the petitioner was earlier granted regular bail but his bail and surety bonds were cancelled by the trial Court as he got absented on 06.11.2024 without any intimation to the Court concerned.
5. Apparently, it appears that this was single default on the part of the petitioner which resulted into cancellation of his bail order.
6. In light of the above and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the present petition is hereby disposed of in the interest of justice and in order to avoid any further delay in the trial with direction to the petitioner to appear before the trial Court within next 10 days and on his doing so, the petitioner is to be released on regular bail by the said Court to its own satisfaction subject to cost of Rs.5000/- to be deposited by the petitioner with the District Legal Services Authority concerned. However, the petitioner is directed to remain careful in future and should appear before the Court concerned on each and every date fixed in the trial.
7. The present petition is disposed of in aforesaid terms.
