1. Admittedly, the petitioner has not availed the statutory remedy of filing an appeal under Section 107 of the Central Goods and Services Tax Act, 2017. We do not intend to invoke our jurisdiction under Article 226 of the Constitution of India at this stage and the petitioner will be free to take up all his contentions in appeal as the Appellate Authority would have larger scope to examine all the facts, record and to pass appropriate order. If such an appeal is preferred within a period of 15 days from today, we expect that the appeal be decided expeditiously preferably within a period of four months.
2. With the aforementioned observations, the present writ petition is dismissed with the liberty aforesaid.
