1. The present petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ of mandamus directing the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and restraining respondent Nos. 4 and 6 to interfere in her personal life.
2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has moved a representation dated 16.12.2023 (Annexure P-1), addressed to respondent No. 2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Amritsar (Rural) and respondent No. 3-SHO, Police Station Lopoke, Amritsar (Rural), raising her grievances as raised in the present petition but the same has not yet been considered and no action has been taken thereon. He further submits that at this stage, the petitioner would feel satisfied if appropriate directions are

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issued to respondent No. 2 to decide the aforesaid representation filed by the petitioner and take necessary action thereon.

3. Notice of motion.
4. Mr. P. S. Pandher, AAG, Punjab, who is present in Court, has accepted the notice on behalf of the respondent-State and submits that the needful will be done in due course. Let a complete set of the paperbook be supplied to him during the course of the day.
5. In view of the limited prayer made by the petitioner, without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of at this stage with a direction to respondent No. 2 to decide the aforesaid representation of the petitioner within a period of two months from today, by passing a speaking order in accordance with law. Needless to say, if any threat is found to the petitioner, the official respondents would provide her adequate security in order to protect her life and liberty.
