While issuing notice of motion on 21.12.2023 following order
was passed:

“Prayer is for quashing of order dated 18.08.2023 passed
by Additional District and Sessions Judge, Amritsar whereby the
bail granted to the petitioner has been ordered to be cancelled.
Bail bonds and surety bonds furnished by the petitioner have
also been ordered to be forfeited to the State.

Petitioner has been booked in the FIR No.92 dated
27.03.2017 Police Station Division-A, Amritsar registered under
Sections 148, 149, 201, 379-B(2), 411, 506 of IPC.

During the course of trial, the petitioner was ordered to
be summoned however despite summoning, he failed to appear
before the trial Court leading to passing of the impugned order.

The petitioner is granted liberty to appear before the
concerned Court on the next date of hearing which as per
counsel for the petitioner falls today i.e. 21.12.2023.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Tarun Aggarwal, Sr. DAG, Punjab appears and accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and seeks time to file reply.

Adjourned to 31.01.2024.

Impugned order dated 18.08.2023 (Anneuxre P-1) shall be kept in abeyance subject to the condition that the petitioner shall appear before the trial Court today itself.

Copy of the order be given to the counsel for the petitioner under the signatures of the Bench Secretary of this Court ”

- 2. Counsel for the petitioner has referred to Para 9 of the short reply filed by way of affidavit of Gurinderbir Singh, PPS, Assistant Commissioner of Police, East, Amritsar on behalf of respondent/State, to submit that the petitioner has now appeared before the Trial Court on 21.12.2023.
- 3. In view of above, order dated 21st of December, 2023 passed by this Court is made absolute. The petitioner shall furnish bail bonds afresh.
- 4. Petition stands disposed off accordingly.
