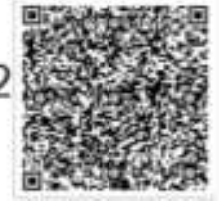

The prayer in the present petition under Section 483 of BNSS (Corresponding Section 439 Cr.P.C.) is for the grant of interim regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.44 dated 21.05.2022 under Section 22 of the NDPS Act, 1985 and Section 29 of NDPS Act added later on vide DDR No.39 dated 21.05.2022, registered at Police Station Smalsar, District Moga, Punjab on account of marriage of his daughter, namely, Jashanpreet Kaur on 10.12.2024.

Looking at the antecedents of the petitioner, I do not deem it appropriate to grant interim regular bail to the petitioner. However, in view of the fact that the daughter of the petitioner is to get married on 10.12.2024,

the Jail Superintendent concerned is directed to send the petitioner/Jalandhar

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Singh in custody to the place including the Gurudwara Sahib where the marriage ceremony is to take place between 8.00 a.m. to 8.00 p.m. for three days i.e. w.e.f. 09.12.2024 to 11.12.2024. The expenses incurred for the aforesaid purpose shall be borne by the petitioner.

The present petition stands disposed of.
