1. The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 for initiating contempt proceedings against the respondents for disobedience of order dated 28.08.2023 passed by this court in CWP-17393-2023.

2. In compliance of order dated 26.02.2024, the counsel for respondents has placed on record reply by way of affidavit filed on behalf of respondents, which is taken on record. The Registry is directed to scan the same and make it part of the soft copy of the case.

3. The counsel for the respondents, after going through the aforesaid affidavit, has submitted that the order, qua which contempt was asserted, has since been complied with by passing speaking order on the legal notice served by the petitioner. No further action is required in the matter. Accordingly, the present petition has been rendered as infructuous.

4. Dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.



5. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left unaddressed, he will be at liberty to avail any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
