Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of directions to respondents No. 2 and 3 to provide security to the petitioner and her family members as they have apprehension at the hands of antisocial elements and terrorists.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner has contested Assembly Election from Budlada constituency as congress candidate and after that till date she is working as Senior Vice President of the Congress Committee and area Incharge of Budlada from the Congress party. Learned counsel has further submitted that Sh. Hakam Singh father-in-law of the petitioner remained Member of Parliament from 1980 to 1985 and was unfortunately murdered by the terrorists in the year 1983. Learned counsel submits that the

petitioner has also filed representation (Annexure P-2) dated 27.09.2023 to the



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Additional Director General of Police (Security) Chandigarh and representation (Annexure P-3) dated 12.10.2023 to the Senior Superintendent of Police, District Mansa raising her apprehension as mentioned in the present petition but the same have not yet been considered and no action has been taken thereon. He further submits that at this stage, the petitioner would be satisfied if appropriate directions are issued to respondent No. 2– Additional Director General of Police (Security), Chandigarh to decide the aforementioned representation filed by the petitioner and take necessary action thereon.

3. As per the status report filed by learned State counsel on the last date of hearing, it has been stated that the Special Director General of Police, Internal Security, Punjab vide report dated 28.05.2024, has reported that the matter regarding fresh threat perception of Smt. Ranvir Kaur Mia, has been examined. According to the field unit report and office record, at present there is no specific threat input indicating any threat to her security from any terrorist/militant/gangster outfits operating in the country.

4. In view of the above, no further directions are required to be passed in the present petition and the same is disposed of accordingly.
